THE PERFORMANCE LEVEL REVIEW FEE OF \$50.00 WILL BE APPLIED TO ANY ADDITIONAL APPLICATION COSTS IF OUR REVIEW INDICATES THAT THE SEWAGE SYSTEM WILL HAVE TO BE CHANGED AS A RESULT OF YOUR PROPOSAL.

IF YOU ANSWER NO TO ALL OF THE ABOVE QUESTIONS YOU MAY APPLY FOR YOUR BUILDING PERMIT. PLEASE RETAIN A COPY OF THIS FORM FOR YOUR RECORDS.
