



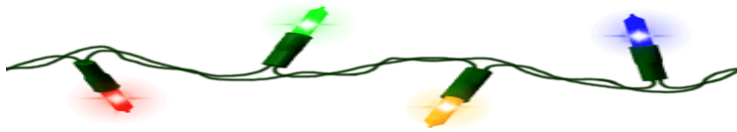

Laird Township reminds everyone to drive safe this winter and recommends preparing an Emergency Kit to keep in your vehicle. Please consider the following items for your kit:

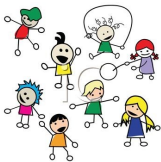


- Snow Shovel
