## Spring Clean-Up

Council has set disposal site hours for spring clean-up days as Friday, Saturday and Sunday after the Victoria Day weekend, **May 22, 23 & 24, 2015**. Hours for **Friday are 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.** and **Saturday and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.** There is no charge for household waste during these days, businesses are excluded.

Please compact all cardboard. Items to be burned will not be accepted during a fire ban. The share-shed will **NOT** take upholstered furniture. Please separate material, and do not put any recyclable material in the land fill! TVs should not be placed in the metal bin, only **metal** objects. Electronics should be taken to the Community Recycling Depot.

## Household Special Waste Facility

The **Household Special Waste Facility** is now open at 115 Industrial Park Crescent, Sault Ste. Marie, (705) 759-5201 (every Thursday and Friday from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm and Saturdays from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm during the months of May through October.

## Community Recycling Depot

Community Recycling Depot offers free recycling of computers, televisions, and miscellaneous electronics (VCRs, CD players, cell phones, etc.). Styrofoam may be recycled here, for a small fee. Call (705) 256-2805 for more information.

The Community Recycling Depot is located at 285 Wilson St (near bottom of Bruce Street hill). Year-round operation, Monday - Friday 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM

## Miscellaneous

**Dog tags** are now due, at no cost to the owner. Proof of rabies vaccination within the last 24 months must be shown. Please remember it is unlawful to have your dog **running at large**, and fines may be levied for dogs found on township or private property.

A reduced **speed** limit has been established for **Pumpkin Point Rd. E.** from Hwy 17 E. to Government Road. 60 km/hr has been set for this section of the road.

**Please get your fire permit at the municipal office. There is no charge for the permit. Permits are required from April 1 to October 31 in any year.**
