NO PARKING ON ROADS



Winter is here and the roads may be treacherous from time to time. As a courtesy to others, please refrain from parking on the road. This will allow the snow plow and others to travel safely over the roads.

Just a reminder that pushing snow onto the roadway is unsafe and illegal.

Fire permits are required from April 1 to October 31, renewed every year at **no cost**. You must come into the Township Office to sign for a permit. Although a permit is not required November 1 to March 31, the same rules and regulations apply to burning.



Every Person or resident in the township of Laird who is the owner of a dog shall register the dog with the Clerk-Treasurer on or before the 1st day of May in each and **every year**.

No person who owns, harbours or possesses any dog shall allow the dog to run at large or trespass on private property.

Interim tax bills will be out by the end of February
