### Fall Clean-Up:

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Council has set disposal site hours for fall clean-up days as:

<b>Saturday</b>	<b>October 17, 2020</b>	<b>9 a.m. to 5 p.m.</b>
<b>Sunday</b>	<b>October 18, 2020</b>	<b>9 a.m. to 5 p.m.</b>

There is no charge for all household waste during these days, businesses are excluded. Please do not put recyclable material in the land fill.

If you are bringing old stoves/washers/dryers, please put them up beside the metal bin so as they can be easily moved into bin.

We accept refrigerators, freezers and dehumidifiers, these items are to be placed beside the metal recycling bin. A FEE of \$30.00 will be charged before drop off, for each item without the appropriate tag indicating refrigerant has been removed.

Share shed is closed, items will not be accepted.

### Looking for a Share Shed Volunteer:

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Do you want to volunteer for the municipality? The share shed at the waste disposal site may remain closed should a volunteer not come forward to assume the responsibility of managing this area. Covid-19 safety measures require that someone be accountable for monitoring procedures established by the Algoma Public Health for such an activity.

### Municipal Office:

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Plans are underway to have the Municipal Office accessible to the public in the coming weeks. Payments can continue to be made on-line or left in the secure drop box at the steps of the municipal office.

Once PPE arrives, we will have new procedures to follow in order to come into the office:

- Door bell, to be used to notify staff of your arrival.
- Masks must be worn when in building.
- One person at a time in building.
- COVID screening and confidential sign-in done prior to entering main office.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided to be used upon entry and exit.
