Spring Clean-Up

Council has set disposal site hours for spring clean-up days as Friday, Saturday and Sunday after the Victoria Day weekend, **May 24, 25 & 26, 2013**. Hours for **Friday are 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.** and **Saturday and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.** There is no charge for all household waste during these days, businesses are excluded. Items to be burned will not be accepted if a fire ban is in place. Do not put recyclable material in the land fill!

The facility is open every Thursday and Friday from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm and Saturdays from 8:00 am until 4:00 pm during the months of April through October.
