THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAIRD

By-law Number 1022-20

Being a By-law providing for the erection of a stop sign at an intersection.

WHEREAS Section 137 (a) of *The Highway Traffic Act* (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H8) provides that the Council of a municipality may by By-Law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction and every sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry of Transportation;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAIRD ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The intersection of the Highways set out in Column 1 are designated as an intersection where a stop sign shall be erected at the location shown in Column 2 to replace an existing yield sign.

Pumpkin Point Road and Point Drive

Southbound on Point Drive

- 2. The penalties provided in Section 214 of *The Highway Traffic Act* shall apply to offenses against this By-Law.
- 3. That every sign so erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry of Transportation.
