## Newspaper Bin

**Newspaper, magazines, household fine paper, catalogues, and telephone books**

- Includes advertising inserts and glossy flyers
- White, brown or colored writing and mailed papers
- Photocopy paper and envelopes
- No carbon, tissue or paper towels
- Hard covers removed from books

## Cardboard Bin

**Corrugated cardboard**

- Layered cardboard boxes with a ripple between the layers
- Keep newspaper separated from cardboard
- No plastic or wax board
- Please flatten or cut boxes

## Glass Bin

**Glass bottles & Jars**

- Clear and coloured food and beverage containers only
- Please rinse the bottles and jars to remove any food or residue left in the container
- Please remove lids from bottles and jars, and place lids in commingled bin
- You do not have to remove labels from glass containers


## Commingled Bin

**Metal food and beverage containers**

- Steel and aluminum food and beverage cans
- Rinse and remove lids or put into cans
- Aluminum trays and foil (must be clean)
- Milk Cartons & Juice Boxes

**NEW**

**Plastic bottles and jars**

- Check your plastic container for the sign...  

- Plastic pop bottles, water bottles, soap, anti-freeze, laundry detergent or Javex bottles. Remove plastic caps and lids and place loose in bin.

## **We Accept Tires:**



No charge for depositing tires at the Laird Disposal Site.

Please make sure to remove rims.

Place tires in designated area.

## **Please DO NOT recycle the following items in the recycle bins at the Laird Disposal Site:**

- Coffee cups
  - Styrofoam packing
  - Diapers
  - Toys (plastic or other)
  - Ceramics, dishes or window glass
  - Hazardous waste, (syringes, medicines)
  - Plastic pails with metal handles
  - Oil or antifreeze jugs

## **Items NOT taken at our site:**

- Fridges
- Batteries
- Used Oils
- Paints
- Hazardous Materials
- Liquids
- Biomedical Wastes
- Radioactive Materials (Florescent bulbs)
- Clean white Styrofoam
- Computer & other electronic devises

### **Household Hazardous Waste Depot**

The **Household Hazardous Waste Depot** has been relocated to 402 Fifth Line East (SSM City Landfill).

Opening date is June 7, 2016.

Tuesday to Saturday - 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM (June 7, 2016 to October 31, 2016)

Monday to Friday - 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM (November 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017)

### **Community Recycling Depot**

Community Living Algoma (in partnership with Clean North and the City of Sault Ste. Marie) has opened a Community Recycling Depot offering free recycling of computers, televisions, styrofoam and miscellaneous electronics (VCRs, CD players, cell phones, etc.) Call (705) 256-2805 for more information.
