

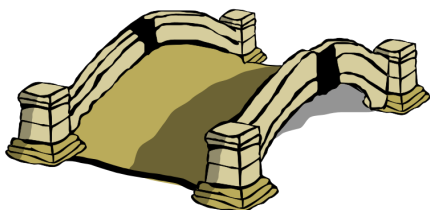

Speed Limits:



You are requested to obey speed limits on all Township of Laird municipal roads for the safety of everyone.

Public Safety Message:



If you arrive at a scene with downed power lines:

- Do not clear tree branches or other storm debris until the power is disconnected or powerlines are repaired.
- Downed powerlines may be live. Stay back at least 10 metres or 33 feet (the length of a school bus). Electricity can travel through water and the ground around powerlines.
- Utility crews must deem the area eclectically safe prior to enter.

Immediately call the local electrical utility to report any downed wires.

PROOF OF IDENTITY AND RESIDENCE:

A person voting must present prescribed proof of identity and residence or complete an application in the prescribed form, including a statutory declaration that he or she is the elector shown on the voters' list.

PROXY APPLICATIONS:

If you are unable to vote on any of the dates set for voting, you can appoint someone to act as your "proxy." This allows you to appoint another elector to attend the voting place and cast your vote on your behalf. You can obtain a Proxy Voting Application form at the Clerk's Office. Once you fill it out and sign it, the person voting on your behalf must bring the form to the Clerk's Office to complete the proxy appointment process. The deadline for making application to vote by proxy is 5:00 p.m. on October 22, 2018.
