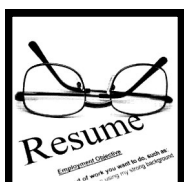

### CLOSURE: Lakeview Bridge

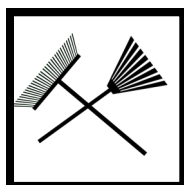

## Spring Clean-Up

Council has set disposal site hours for spring clean-up days as:

<b>Saturday</b>	<b>May 25, 2019</b>	<b>9 a.m. to 5 p.m.</b>
<b>Sunday</b>	<b>May 26, 2019</b>	<b>9 a.m. to 5 p.m.</b>

There is no charge for all household waste during these days, businesses are excluded. Items to be burned will not be accepted if a fire ban is in place. Do not put recyclable material in the land fill!

## Items not taken at the Laird Waste Disposal Site:

- Batteries
- Used Oils
- Paints, unless dried in can
- Hazardous Materials
- Liquids
- Biomedical Wastes
- Radioactive Materials (Florescent bulbs)
- Computer & other electronic devises

## Share Shed Guidelines

### ACCEPTABLE Items Include:

- ✓ Small Household Items
- ✓ Books and Magazines
- ✓ Children's Toys (NO Fabric)
- ✓ Sports Equipment
- ✓ Small Appliances (in working condition)
- ✓ Tools (in working condition)

### UNACCAPTABLE Items Include:

- ✗ Hazardous Materials or Waste
- ✗ Liquids of any kind
- ✗ Clothing or Stuffed Animals
- ✗ Large Appliances
- ✗ Microwave Ovens
- ✗ Upholstery Furniture

## Household Hazardous Waste Depot

The **Household Hazardous Waste Depot** is located at 402 Fifth Line East (SSM City Landfill).

Electronics are accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste Depot. Please remove all power cords prior to drop off.

Open Tuesday to Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (April 2, 2019 to October 26, 2019).
