Fire Permits



Fire permits are required from April 1 to October 31, renewed every year at **no cost**.

Property owners can now go to the township website at lairdtownship.ca and request a fire permit under the *Forms and Documents* section. The property owner is requested to fill in required information. Once submitted, the person and the administrative office will receive an e-mail with a pdf copy of their fire permit, that they can then print. If you do not have access to a computer please contact the office at (705) 248-2395 and someone will assist you.

If you are not the property owner you must have consent in writing from the property owner to obtain a permit on their behalf.

The owner will be notified once their request is reviewed and when the dog tag is ready for pick up at the office. ACCEPTABLE Items Include:

- ✓ Small Household Items
- ✓ Books and Magazines
- ✓ Children's Toys (NO Fabric)
- ✓ Sports Equipment
- ✓ Small Appliances (in working condition)

UNACCEPTABLE Items Include:

- ✗ Hazardous Materials or Waste
- ✗ Liquids of any kind
- ✗ Clothing or Stuffed Animals
- ✗ Large Appliances
- ✗ Microwave Ovens
- ✗ Upholstered Furniture

The **Household Hazardous Waste Depot** is located at 402 Fifth Line East (SSM City Landfill).

Electronics are accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste Depot. Please remove all power cords prior to drop off.

The Household Hazardous Waste Depot is scheduled to open on April 6, 2021. Open Tuesday to Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
