There will be no charge for all household waste during these days, businesses are excluded. Do not put recyclable material in the landfill!

## Items not taken at the Laird Waste Disposal Site:

- Batteries
- Used Oils
- Paints, unless dried in can
- Liquids
- Biomedical Wastes
- Radioactive Materials (Florescent bulbs)
- Hazardous Materials

## Share Shed Guidelines

### **ACCEPTABLE** Items Include:

- ✓ Small Household Items
- ✓ Books and Magazines
- ✓ Children's Toys (NO Fabric)
- ✓ Sports Equipment
- ✓ Small Appliances (in working condition)
- ✓ Tools (in working condition)

### **UNACCEPTABLE** Items Include:

- ✗ Hazardous Materials or Waste
- ✗ Liquids of any kind
- ✗ Clothing or Stuffed Animals
- ✗ Large Appliances
- ✗ Microwave Ovens
- ✗ Upholstered Furniture
- ✗ Any broken, damaged or stained items

## Household Hazardous Waste Depot

The **Household Hazardous Waste Depot** is located at 402 Fifth Line East (SSM City Landfill).

Electronics are accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste Depot. Please remove all power cords prior to drop off.

The Household Hazardous Waste Depot is **OPEN** for 2022, will close **October 22, 2022**.  
**Open Tuesday to Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.**
