Career Opportunity - Machine Operator Repairer

The Machine Operator Repairer has the responsibility for operating equipment including a plow truck, backhoe, and grader for the safe removal of snow and for maintenance of the roads. The Machine Operator Repairer has the responsibility for participating in long-term road planning and decision making with respect to equipment, repairs, emergency road repairs, and operations. The Machine Operator Repairer is required to be on call and will work extended hours as required under the direction of the Road Superintendent.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Completion of Grade 12 or equivalent;
- Minimum two years of related experience required, preferably in a municipal environment;
- Thorough knowledge and experience of road maintenance and construction and operation of related equipment including plow truck with wing and sander, grader, backhoe, steam jenny, and general shop tools;
- Valid DZ License with clean driver abstract;
- Certified chainsaw safety and operator;
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively as a member of a team;
- Excellent organizational, time management, communication, and interpersonal skills; and
- Living within the community is considered an asset.

Property Taxes

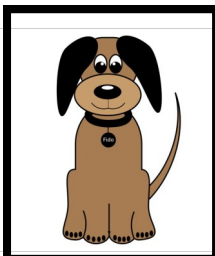

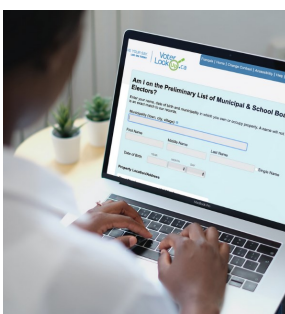
Dog Tags



Property owners with dogs can go to the Township website at lairdtownship.ca under the *Forms and Documents* section and request a dog tag, at **no cost**. The owner will be notified once the dog tag is ready for pick up at the office. If you require assistance contact the office at (705) 248-2395 and someone will be happy to assist. Please remember it is unlawful to have your dog *running at large* and fines may be levied.

You are required to register your dog every year, a new year a new tag!
