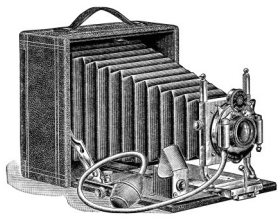

Grounds Keeper Assistant

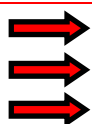
Successful candidate will work with the Township Grounds Manager to perform grounds keeper duties throughout the Township.
