



Yard Maintenance By-Law 1090-23



Council passed a Yard Maintenance By-law 1090-23 on July 20, 2023.

Municipal Taxes:



Final Tax Bills for 2023 were issued and mailed the week of June 16. The first installment was due July 14, 2023, and the final installment for 2023 is due September 15, 2023.

If you require a receipt for payments, you must inform the office in advance. To prevent waste we do not send out a receipt unless requested.

Finns' Bay Road Parking:

Township of Laird Zoning By-Law 531, under section 4.11 defines a dwelling as "a building used in whole as the home residence or sleeping place of one or more persons either continuously, permanently, temporarily or transiently, **but does NOT include ... mobile home**. Section 9.2(ii) states that under residential uses, one single family detached dwelling is permitted. The use of a trailer (mobile home) as living accommodations is in contravention of the Zoning By-law. Complaints of people living in trailers have been received and are being investigated.


