### The Wharf:

Council is pleased to inform the ratepayers that it has purchased “the wharf” property from Public Works and Government Services Canada, and is in the process of developing a plan that will be shared with the public. It is recognized that a boat launch is desperately needed for the municipality and this will be foremost in council’s plans for the property. Parking facilities are envisioned to accept cars, trucks and trailers, to keep them from being left on Finns’ Bay Road North. A *tentative date of September 4, 2013* is scheduled for a public meeting. The date and time will be advertised closer to the actual time. Council welcomes your attendance at the meeting, and invites comments on this project.

### Disposal Site:

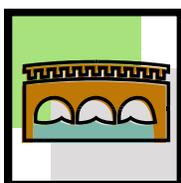

Council applied to the Municipal Infrastructure Investment Initiative (MIICP) and was successful in obtaining funding for the Government Road Bridge over the Bar River. The Provincial Government has committed to providing \$1,305,988.00 towards this project. The design stage will be implemented shortly.
